Reports and disclosures of Sexual Harassment, Sexual Violence, Sexual Misconduct, Domestic Violence and Stalking

Academic Year 2018-19

This document relates to reports and disclosures of sexual harassment, sexual violence, sexual misconduct, domestic violence and stalking received by Goldsmiths, University of London. You can report a report or disclosure using the [Report and Support](#) online reporting tool in academic year 2018-2019.

It is the second iteration of these figures which are published on an annual basis. Full definitions of what constitutes a report or a disclosure, and an explanation of how the College can respond to a report or a disclosure, can be found in the [Sexual Violence, Sexual Harassment and Sexual Misconduct](#).

It is worth noting that reporting is a survivor led process enabling anyone using this system to choose if they wish to remain anonymous or share their details with the College and how they wish to describe their report or disclosure. The number of reports or disclosures does not correlate directly to individuals using the system; for example, one person is able to make multiple submissions.
